What is *Preprints*?

Preprints (www.preprints.org) is an open access archive for scholarly work that has not yet been peer-reviewed. The multidisciplinary platform facilitates early showcasing of articles in all research fields and disciplines.

Submit to *Preprints* – Quick and Effortless!

- Provide basic information about the manuscript and authors.
- Upload a Word or LaTeX file along with a PDF, any supplementary files, and a graphical abstract.
- Manage the submission status in your user profile.

What happens after I submit?

- Your article will be checked by our in-house editors within 24 hours.
- Accepted submissions will be published online immediately and assigned a digital object identifier (DOI).
- You can submit a new version of a preprint at any time. All versions are assigned a DOI and can be cited independently.
- Reviewers can leave comments about your paper and suggest how to improve and build on your work.

Reporting Scholarly Research

Preprints publishes any article that reports original research results or a comprehensive review of a field. The following types are accepted: Article, Review, Conference Paper, Data Descriptor, Brief Report, Case Report, Communication, Short Note, Technical Note, Hypothesis.

What Makes *Preprints* Special?

- We archive preprints from all research fields.
- We make research instantly discoverable, sharable and citable.
- Authors can upload a new version at any time.
- Establish precedence of your research and make it discoverable.

Why Posting on *Preprints* Matters?

- Establish precedence and receive feedback.
- Credit referees' contributions.
- Transparent academic communication.
- Preserve the original manuscript as a record of your work.
